

Coachman Lusso II

Candy Evans takes a first look at one of Yorkshire's finest, a caravan that's been significantly upgraded for 2026



Coachman has always been known for its high-spec caravans, so when it releases a new version of its top-of-the-range model you can expect something special.

Much has been upgraded for the 2026 Lusso II, with its stylish island-bed, rear-washroom and L-shaped front seating layout.

The lowdown

This latest version of the Lusso – and Coachman's consistently strong showing in our Owner Satisfaction Awards (it won Best Caravan Manufacturer, Pre-owned and New again this year) – should make this a good investment. Though, you're likely to buy because of the joy of the luxurious holiday accommodation. This all assumes your wallet and tow car can cope with it, of course.

1 The new AL-KO galvanised steel chassis on the 2026 Lusso allows for an optional upgrade to a maximum mass of 2,200kg, one of the highest on the market in the UK, and its smart exterior graphics should make sure your campsite neighbours appreciate the quality of your accommodation.

2 The smart seating area has a movable footstool and no fewer than three different designs of scatter cushion. The eye-level cupboards have concave fronts and leave space for a large panoramic window above the traditional three-window front panel, so the living space is filled with light.

3 The curved L-shaped kitchen makes the most of the Lusso's 2.44m (8ft) width and the corner cupboard opens





completely to reveal slide-out racking, making the storage space accessible. The Thetford cooker even has domestic-style temperature settings for the oven, making baking more accurate.

4 The work surface is another place where the Lusso's quality of materials is clear – the composite material wouldn't look out of place in a luxury apartment.

5 The double bed has a new, deep mattress for 2026 and it retracts easily so you can reach the washroom during the day. Bedside cabinets, overhead lockers, a small corner dresser and a sizeable wardrobe give plenty of space for your kit in the bedroom.

6 The rear washroom has a sleek black heated towel rail beside the swivel-bowl toilet. The marble-effect mirror surround above the basin and its vanity unit are matched in large panels in the spacious shower cubicle, where you'll find moulded shelves in the corner to take your toiletries.

7 When it gets dark, there are many layered ambient and directional lighting options, including some smart touch-controlled, adjustable reading lights at the head of the bed, which each have a USB socket.

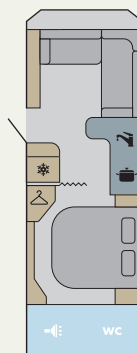
8 There's much more to the Lusso than can fit on these pages, but I particularly like the lovely new voile panel that forms the window dressing in the bedroom and the aircon unit, which comes as standard.
