True, it did not have the outside styling of the Pastiche, the VIP or the Laser ranges, but I was really taken by the makeover of the interior. It was very stylish, and had that rather cosy feeling, which is essential when you are caravanning throughout the winter months.

After pitching up, the caravan drew a great deal of admiring glances. It performed very well over the six nights away, and the only thing I missed was the roof


extractor fan when cooking - but it was not a huge problem.

I find the Amara 520/4 layout suits me down to the ground, but with nine layouts in the range there is one to suit any requirements!


I look forward to bringing you my reports on the caravan over the next six months.


